What we learned after two rounds of support to the co-creation process



For support from the OGP MDTF to achieve lasting impact, we will work with awardees to:

- Shift focus of award from broadening engagement to development of ambitious and impactful reforms.
- Deepen dialogue and build constructive engagement among relevant stakeholders.
- Support a process to deliberate and prioritize open government reforms.
- Play a more active role in sustaining engagement to monitor Action Plan implementation.
- Work more closely with government and civil society organization to provide technical advice and guidance.



Our 2020 Objectives

Objectives and Scope of Work

The OGP MDTF will hire a CSO as a contractor to facilitate a set of activities suited to address the national context.



Improve the design and ambition of Action Plans



Enhance the quality of engagement and dialogue during Action Plan design



Strengthen the process for deliberation and prioritization



Sustain engagement and improve monitoring during implementation of commitments



Promote collaboration and coordination among government and civil society

Additional information

- **All activities must achieve concrete results for the OGP process and reforms in the country.**
- Lead applicant must work together with government and civil society in MSF.
- We expect one organization per country to apply.
- Applicants are encouraged to apply as part of a coalition/ consortium focused on complementary roles to jointly deliver the activities.
- The OGP MDTF will select 3-4 countries.
- Amount of each one-year award may not exceed USD 60,000.



Selection Process

Two phased selection process

1

Request for Expression of Interest aims to identify CSOs with experience engaging in open government and OGP.

2

Request for Proposal aims to identify shortlisted CSOs with coherent and creative ideas to find solutions to develop more ambitious Action Plans.

The Request for Expression of Interest provides opportunity for applicants to:

- Demonstrate extent of experience engaging in open government and OGP.
- Provide initial ideas on how additional funding to the co-creation process would result in a more ambitious action plan and help the country go beyond business as usual.
- Present organization's credibility and capacity.

More on the Eligibility Criteria

- **Relevant Experience** – previous engagement or facilitation on open government or OGP
- **Credibility** – acceptability by government and civil society
- **Civil Society Eligibility** – governance, financial accountability, legal status, institutional capacity, etc.

+ The OGP MDTF Implementation Team will also assess:

- Potential for Impact
- Alignment with OGP values, principles and strategic priorities
- Consistency with World Bank Country Strategy

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Enter the following information and click 'Submit' to create an account for the World Bank's eConsultant2 system. A confirmation will be sent to your email address.

A business need not be an approved World Bank Vendor nor have submitted a Registration Application in order to express interest or submit a proposal. A Registration Application is only required for firms who have been recommended for an award. To be approved as a registered World Bank Vendor, the business enterprise must complete the Vendor Registration Application and be able to demonstrate that it has been and is offering goods/services under the business name. Sole Proprietors must be able to demonstrate that they have been engaged in their business activity for not less than one year.


