I. Eligibility Update & findings

The C&S Subcommittee has the mandate of overseeing the annual update of OGP eligibility scores. The Support Unit presented the main findings from the most recent update completed, including changes from the previous year's scores, which were summarized in a memo tabled for C&S endorsement.

C&S members suggested considering the impact of the eligibility scores on OGP Local members in future updates, including the possibility of allowing Local members from non-OGP participating countries. Subcommittee members also recommended exploring graphic visualizations of country eligibility status on the OGP website to reflect the different categories of findings included in the memo presented.

Decision: C&S endorsed the 2022 eligibility update presented by the SU. The memo will be shared with the full Steering Committee and the updated database will be published on the OGP website.
