On behalf of the Municipality of Sarchí, I would like to inform our interest in joining the OGP Local program.

Sarchí, a small town located in the western region of Costa Rica, with a population of around 22,000 people, is well known for its natural exuberance and the tradition of typical paintings of the oxcart.

The Municipality, founded in 1949, aims the vision "to be an effective and efficient local government, which promotes civic participation, assertive communication and strategical alliances, seeking an integral, inclusive, and sustainable development, providing innovative services to the citizens of Sarchí."

Since May 2020, as a mayor, I have been promoting actions to create an open government culture in the Municipality, starting policies and developing projects in a more open, accountable, and responsive local government.

For example:

 In 2020, we joint the project "Continued Civil Society Engagement -Government Strengthening" of the Trust for the Americas and the



Organization of American States (OAS), which provided workshops and training on open government topics.

- In 2021, after a broad consultation and participation process, the Human Development Plan 2021-2031 was approved with the support of the United Nations Development Program (UNDP). In the same line, the Municipality Strategical Plan 2021-2026 was approved and included commitments like implementing participatory budgeting.
- Since 2021, the Municipality has been a member of the Network of Local Governments Promoting the Sustainable Development Goals, a platform to share and learn how to implement the SDGs in the local agenda.
- From 2020 to date, the Municipality has strengthened the dialogue and communication channels with several stakeholders like the local chamber of community organizations, the chamber of the private sector, and civil society organizations such as culture and environment.
- Recently, we joined the project "Data visualization for the local government's transparency" coordinated by the Trust for the Americas and the Organization of American States (OAS) in Costa Rica.
- We are implementing a strategy to update the legal framework to help us move forward and improve the services provided by the local government, including the ethical behavior of our public servants.

We know that we start the way and that the open government reforms take time to be accomplished and show results; this is why it is relevant for us to join the OGP Local program as a platform for capacity building and collaboration. Moreover, we recognize the outstanding role that Open Government Partnership plays in creating a more secure, democratic, and prosperous world.

We are looking forward to joining the OGP Local's 2022 cohort.
