Dear Secretary Cusma Saldaña,

We welcome the Government of Peru's participation in the Open Government Partnership (OGP), which now comprises 76 countries and 106 local governments working to implement open government commitments to promote greater transparency, accountability and citizen engagement in policy-making.

As you are aware, all OGP participating governments are expected to co-create an Action Plan outlining a concrete set of open government reforms, in line with OGP Participation and Co-Creation standards.

We have closely followed the latest developments in the country and are deeply concerned about the political and social crises, which have taken the lives of citizens over the past two months.

We acknowledge the work your office has undertaken over the past year and the collaboration enhanced with civil society and academia within the OGP multi-stakeholder forum to co-create the new open government national action plan. We also understand that in this context it is very difficult to make commitments to future endeavors.

However, since the OGP Support Unit did not receive the new action plan by the 31 December 2022 deadline and in order to maintain a consistent and fair approach to enforcing OGP requirements asked of all participating countries, the government of Peru is considered to have acted contrary to the OGP process for the 2022-2024 cycle.

The OGP Support Unit and Steering Committee stand ready to support you during this process.
