Subject : Letter of intent - Call for Expressions of Interest to OGP local 2024

The Regional Government of Cajamarca expresses its intention to join the Open Government Partnership, recognizing the importance of this international multilateral initiative in supporting the efforts of governments and civil society to enhance transparency and access to public information, citizen participation, accountability and integrity to improve the relationship between the State and the citizens.

I fully endorse the commitment to defend the principles expressed in the Open Government Declaration. This commitment is evident in our support for the reform of the participatory budget process through the design and implementation of the digital platform "Cajamarca Democrática y Participativa". This initiative aims to increase citizen participation in the thirteen provinces and make the process more representative and equitable. Likewise, I am willing to support citizen participation as it has been done in the formulation processes of the territorial plan and institutional plans, promoting this principle in other processes that require the participation of actors in the institution.

My dedication to public hearings involves promoting this mechanism using various channels and media to keep all citizens informed about the activities and projects that are being implemented. In addition, I have shown political will for the management of collaborative processes between civil society and private sector actors, the Regional Government of Cajamarca has been collaborating with the USAID project Transparent Public Investment, which aims to improve public sector investment processes through multi-stakeholder capacity strengthening to promote integrity in public investment. Likewise, the Regional Government participated in the project "Strengthening Transparency and Accountability Networks among Civil Society" in alliance with Proética, the Peruvian chapter of Transparency International, with whom the participatory budget processes in the Cajamarca region were strengthened.

In this context, I am confident that the Regional Government of Cajamarca is committed to promoting an Open Government culture while sharing our experiences with the Open Government Partnership community.

Consequently, we enthusiastically look forward to our future adherence and the consequent development of an Open Government Action Plan to be formulated through consultations and participation of civil society.
