Dear Mr. Zhorzholiani,

I am writing to follow up on our letter dated May 15, 2025 (attached), regarding Georgia's temporary suspension from the Open Government Partnership (OGP) under Stage Two of the Response Policy.

As noted in that correspondence, in early 2026 the OGP Steering Committee will review progress made by December 31, 2025, to determine whether Georgia's suspension can be lifted or whether it will become permanent. With that date approaching, we would like to kindly remind the Government of Georgia of this deadline and invite you to share any relevant updates, documentation, or evidence of progress toward addressing the concerns raised under the Response Policy. As previously noted, Georgia's active status can be restored at any point during the temporary suspension period, should the original concerns be adequately addressed.

Any information provided to the Support Unit will be compiled and shared with the Steering Committee for its consideration when it assesses the actions taken by the established deadline, in order to determine the next steps regarding Georgia's participation status in OGP.

The Steering Committee remains committed to supporting Georgia's engagement with OGP and encourages continued collaboration with civil society and other stakeholders in this regard.
