My quick observation is on page 19 section III, participation and co- creation. The report only acknowledged the NSC and TWGs While leaving out the Governance and Leadership (G&L) which is also a critical structure under Nigerias OGP implementation. Secondly on same page third paragraph, the report rightly captured the ministry of finance Budget and National Planning as the host ministry. However, due to changes in governments, the name has metamorphosed into first Ministry of Budget and National Planning and now ministry of Budget and economic planning. This is necessary in order to address any ambiguity readers might be faced with trying to match what could be captured in other documents.

Commitment 12 under Annex 1 did not capture the work done by Nigeria Network of NGOs and National Human Rights Commission on the development of the draft document on peaceful protests- policing protests. The Police Toolkit has been developed and validated by stakeholders, this tool will guide the Police in managing demonstrations and protests in a way not to infringe on the fundamental human rights of the protesters while ensuring a peaceful and orderly process. This was done under commitment 12.
