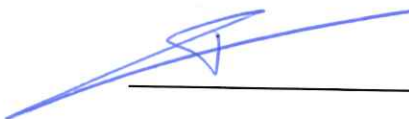


we are deeply committed to honoring that trust by transforming Prishtina into a smarter, more efficient, and significantly cleaner city.
