### Comments Received from the Government of Kosovo (30 July 2026)

#### **Comment on Commitment 1: Advancing and promoting a centralized e-services web portal for Kosovo (eKosova)**

This commitment has been substantially achieved. The Government of Kosovo has successfully advanced and promoted the eKosova centralized e-services portal, significantly expanding digital public services and enabling citizens and businesses to access a wide range of services online. The platform now serves as Kosovo's primary digital gateway for government services and currently provides 326 electronic services across 31 service categories. More than 1.1 million registered users access the platform, which has recorded over 1.4 billion visits and more than 21 million electronic services delivered to citizens, businesses and civil society organizations. The platform also includes online grant and subsidy applications, alongside numerous other public e-services. While some transparency-related elements envisaged in the Action Plan remain under development, the core objective of establishing and promoting a centralized e-services portal has been successfully accomplished.

#### **Comment on Commitment 4.3: Increasing transparency, accountability, and financial control of political parties registered in the Republic of Kosovo**

This commitment has been substantially achieved. Kosovo has established the Office for the Registration, Certification and Financial Control of Political Entities (Zyra për Regjistrimin, Certifikimin dhe Kontrollin Financiar të Subjekteve Politike) within the Central Election Commission, which is responsible for the registration, certification, oversight and financial reporting of political entities. The Office has strengthened the institutional framework for transparency and financial oversight of political parties, contributing to greater accountability in line with the objectives of the commitment. While further improvements in enforcement and public disclosure remain possible, the core institutional objective has been achieved.
