In connection with the participation of West Sumbawa Regency in world innovation through the Open Government Partnership (OGP) in 2020 and the official announcement of the West Sumbawa Regency Government with the West Nusa Tenggara Provincial Government as new members of the local OGP in 2020, we hereby express our gratitude and appreciation for being able to join this local OGP partnership. Next, West Sumbawa Regency Government's action plans are as follows:

1. Strengthening policies/regulations and developing action plans for collaboration, partnership and cooperation between the government, civil society, the private sector in the administration of local government in the regional program for mutual cooperation. This commitment is intended as a joint action plan (gotong royong) in order to maintain the continuity of the 5 pillars of community-based total sanitation (STBM) completion

4. Strengthening the Mainstay Inclusive Equal Service Forum (Yasinan) as a Media for consultation, evaluation, complaints and joint problem resolution

6. Arrangement of the Regional Organization Affairs towards accountable governance that erves.

The action plan that we have prepared is more focused on the aspects of realizing participatory, clean, transparent, innovative, inclusive and accountable local government. We look forward to participating and sharing experiences with local and global OGP participating regions related to our strategic vision and action plans. We will
