Since the integration of the municipality of San Pedro Garza García to the OGP Local program on May 17, 2022, we have been working to achieve our Open Government Local Action Plan. Such Plan has gone through an open, diverse, and high-quality standards process to ensure that the co-created commitments are likely to have a relevant public impact.

This process has been historic due to the conformation of the Nuevo León Abierto Coalition, the only coalition between three different jurisdictions in the world we are proud to be part of. This Local Action Plan is the product of teamwork between the Government of the State of Nuevo León, the municipalities of Monterrey and San Pedro Garza García, the Nuevo León Council for Strategic Planning (CONL), the Nuevo León State Commission for Transparency and Access to Information (INFO NL), and two NGO's (Cómo Vamos Nuevo León and Accountability Lab Mexico).

In addition to these institutions and organizations, the co-creation process has incorporated hundreds of citizens, experts, public servants and academics along the different stages: public consultation for prioritization of themes and issues, co-creation work tables, and finally in the generation and review of the commitment roadmaps.

All of this has culminated in the generation of our **Strategic Vision for the Nuevo León Local Action Plan** seeks to strengthen an open, effective, transparent and innovative Government with responsible, modern and efficient institutions in order to build an Open Nuevo León that is proactively accountable and uses the open government paradigm to place people at the center of every public decision-making process .

This strategic vision matches San Pedro's government vision of generating quality of life in public spaces with citizen engagement. Our public policies have tested many innovations to place citizens at the center of our decision-making. The cocreation of the Action Plan and its commitments is a true example of this view.

In this sense, San Pedro Garza García commits to implement two commitments:

- Open contracting system for participatory budgeting in San Pedro Garza García
- Re-engineering for municipal public service reporting tools in San Pedro Garza García

Additionally, as a coalition, we also commit to work as a team and implement two transversal commitments:

- Opening Strategy on Active and Inclusive Metropolitan Mobility
- Proactive Transparency in Nuevo León

We believe that these actions will not only have a significant public impact in the short, medium and long term, but will be the starting point to need and relevance of open government in our public administrations to transform our cities and the way we relate with the citizenry.
