

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FOREWORD

Having won the primary election to emerge as the Kaduna State governorship candidate of the APC, I am leading the push by the APC Kaduna Team to seek your mandate to continue its legacy of progressive governance that began in 2015. SECURITY, LAW AND ORDER


The APC government of Kaduna State shall ensure the

security of lives and property by:

- Investing further in technology for security and law enforcement.
- **3.** Launching the Kaduna State Security Trust Fund to further support the security agencies
- Scaling up engagement with the Federal Government in a partnership to ensure deployment of security personnel and equipment for adequate provision of security in our dear state.
- Empowering the Kaduna State Peace Commission to strengthen its delivery of its mandate to anticipate and help deter and resolve conflict.
- **9.** Supporting the Federal Government to strengthen security across the road and rail network in the state, leveraging on technology and global security standards.

- 2. Strengthening the Kaduna State Vigilance Service to complement the efforts of the federal security agencies.
- **4.** Deepening intelligence gathering through collaboration with traditional, religious and community leaders to support security agencies.
- 6. Reinvigorating the Kaduna State Counter Terrorism Operations Centre with the participation of all relevant security and law enforcement agencies.
- **8.** Retaining a robust focus on Law and Order through:
 - Accelerated Judicial reforms to enhance the capacity of the judicial system to deliver justice promptly.
 - Enacting a Commercial Code to assist speedy resolution of business disputes.
 - Broadening the Alternative Dispute Resolution window as a pillar in justice delivery.

UPGRADE OF INFRASTRUCTURE



VISION

Consolidate and continue the unprecedented infrastructure upgrade programme of the 2015-2023 APC government, to enhance public welfare and accelerate economic growth.

OVERVIEW

Sustain the comprehensive renewal and regeneration of infrastructure begun by the El-Rufai government, in recognition of the fact that no economy can grow without infrastructure.



INFRASTRUCTURE

We shall consolidate, continue and expand the infrastructure

development programme by:

- Prioritising the implementation of long term Kaduna State Infrastructure Master plan (KADIMP) and the revised Kaduna Master plan as we build on the noble foundations that have been laid in this sector.
- 3. Promoting accelerated rural development by extending infrastructure development to all local government areas, with the goal of supporting our rural communities to achieve rapid economic growth and development.
- Implementing the Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) system as a costeffective, affordable and sustainable mass transit system.

- 2. Completing the master plans for Kafanchan and Zaria to guide the future development of these cities, and to work with our local government councils to cascade planned development across the state.
- **4.** Completing the Urban Renewal Programme, including the soft parts such as parks and gardens.
- **6.** Focus on expanding Power Supply from Hydro, Thermal & Renewable Sources:
 - Build the transmission and distribution infrastructure necessary to evacuate the power from our proposed 84MW plant and ensure last mile delivery to homes and businesses.
 - Conclude engagement with the Federal Government to transfer management or concessioning of the 214MW Kudenda power plant to KDSG.
 - Complete the 100MW solar plant being built as part of the renewable energy drive of the northern states.
 - Seek private partners build more solar power plants and mini-grids and make Kaduna State the centre of renewables.



INFRASTRUCTURE

- Investing in sustainable environmental infrastructure such as water supply, sewage and solid waste management, and adequate infrastructure for job creation.
- **9.** Construction of medium- to low-cost housing estates that will facilitate the Rent-to-Own Scheme for citizens.

We will also:

- Strengthen the public-private partnership model to increase the housing stock.
- Further empower the Mortgage and Foreclosure system in the state to assist residents with affordable home financing.

- 8. Harness and develop water resources by building more dams where needed, like the Greater Kaduna Water Supply Project, and increase the capacity for irrigation.
- **10.** Collaborating with the neighbouring states and the Federal Government to continually improve the quality of connecting roads.
- **11.** Continuing to work with the local government councils and private sector investors to develop more modern markets across the state.
- **12.** Support the Metropolitan Authorities for sustained urban management:
 - Empower the three metropolitan authorities to extend their capacity for robust management of Kaduna, Kafanchan and Zaria as organic cities. These cities will be the hubs from which development radiates across the state.



STRENGTHENING INSTITUTIONS



VISION

A public service system with qualified and motivated staff, efficient in promoting good governance and delivering exceptional public service for citizen welfare and socio-economic growth.

OVERVIEW

Sustained growth and development require the support of a dedicated public service machinery, with skilled personnel who are committed to the public good.



INSTITUTIONS

- We will continue to strengthen the public service for greater efficiency across the three arms of government, the Executive, the Legislature and the Judiciary.
- 3. We will sustain a robust relationship with the two other arms of government to create a conducive atmosphere for the day to day administration of the state.
- **5.** We will continue to be driven by the state fiscal, transparency, accountability and sustainability model.
- 7. We will ensure the full implementation of the e-governance and ICT policy of the state government.
- 9. We will improve provision of accessibility to public buildings by persons living with disability and make policies that will promote their inclusion in all aspects of livelihood.

- 2. We will maintain the strong emphasis on training as the mechanism for continuous improvement in capacity, productivity and efficiency in the Kaduna State public service.
- **4.** Adherence to the Rule of Law shall be our guiding principle.
- 6. The administration will create a conducive atmosphere for robust citizens engagement and buy-in for the state government's policies, programmes and projects.
- **8.** Sustain prompt payment of salaries, pensions and other terminal benefits for the state workforce.

TRADE AND



VISION

A Kaduna State that is the dominant hub for investment and commerce in Nigeria.

OVERVIEW

Sustaining the conditions for economic dynamism through investments, vibrant commercial activities, skills development, and job creation.



SUSTAIN KADUNA STATE'S STATUS AS HOME OF INVESTMENTS

We shall build infrastructure, retain economic competitiveness, and position Kaduna State as the home of agribusiness, light manufacturing, and IT.

INVESTMENTS

Our governance agenda in the economic sector will seek to sustain the enviable status of Kaduna State as a foremost investment destination in Nigeria, attract investments across more sectors, create jobs and promote the transfer technology through:

1. Vigorous Investment promotion

- i. Maintain and improve on the Ease of Doing Business policies and practices that have given the state its business-friendly reputation
- ii. Sustain after-care service for businesses.
- iii. Initiate more public-private partnerships to catalyse priority investment sectors.
 iv. Detain the business friendly tay.
- **iv.** Retain the business friendly tax administration system in the state.

2. Expanding support for Agriculture

- Expand linkages between farm and factory, especially for the major crops grown in the state. Position the Special Agro-processing Zone (SAPZ) to offer a bigger market for farmers and serve as a magnet for increased production in the field and greater value-addition to agricultural produce.
- **ii.** Pursue productivity gains for farmers through more extension services and access to better inputs.
- iii. Encourage mixed farming among smallholder farmers to increase

food security and resilience in rural communities

- iv. Invest in dry season farming by expanding irrigation facilities, through small and earth dams across the state
- v. Public-private partnerships and other initiatives to expand ranching and modern livestock production.
- vi. Support farmers in the dairy sector to make Kaduna State a major milk and derivatives producer.



3. Accelerating the establishment of Light Manufacturing firms

- i. Leverage on the free trade zone status granted to the Green Economic Zone (GEZ) to attract new businesses to set up there.
- **ii.** Build and sustain clusters of small, medium and large-scale industries across all senatorial districts by deepening partnerships with the private sector.

4. Giving priority attention to Mining

- i. Attract more investors into the mining sector and support further exploration of our natural resources.
- **ii.** Take steps to achieve the lawful mining of deposits of lithium, nickel, iron ore, tin, gold, and other valuable minerals identified in the state.

5. Making Kaduna an Information Technology hub

i. We shall consolidate on the policy initiatives and partnerships with the private sector such as the Technology Village, aimed at establishing Kaduna as an IT hub.

SMALL BUSINESSES

- i. Launch small business promotion schemes through free training and provide capacity development opportunities.
- Provide tax incentives for small business owners to employ more people and grow their businesses.
- iii. Help small and medium scale enterprises with access to finance.
- iv. Expand the current microcredit scheme to support small-scale businesses and help improve livelihoods for the urban and rural poor.

FOSTERING INNOVATION

- i. Make Kaduna an Information Technology hub, in partnership with the private sector.
- We shall build the broadband and other infrastructure to make Kaduna a major IT hub and attract IT companies to open businesses here and to help incubate ideas that are birthed in the state.
- iii. We shall take action to position the Technology Village, established by the APC government in partnership with the private sector, as the hub of a viable IT ecosystem in the state.
- iv. Replicate the KadaHive Innovation and Technology Centre across the three senatorial districts.



ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

- 1. Scale partnerships with the private sector to support skills development to support the creation of jobs.
- 2. Create the enabling environment for business incubation centres to thrive and help develop human capital in the state.
- **3.** Establish Kaduna Creative Hub to harness talent in the industry.
- **4.** Provide access to finance and incentives for entrepreneurs to grow their businesses.
- 5. Develop programmes for training and retraining entrepreneurs across different sectors of the economy that have the highest potential for growth and development, such as agriculture, artisanal services, skin care products, apiculture and the like.

TOURISM, ARTS AND CULTURE

- **1.** Promote and encourage tourism assets and potentials across the state.
- 2. Work to become the tourism hub and destination of choice in the northern states of Nigeria by curating and delivering an enjoyable experience.
- 3. In collaboration with stakeholders, harness the visitor economy by providing tangible incentives for visitors through offerings and tourism activities.

AGRICULTURE



VISION

A well-developed, productive system of innovative and technologically driven agriculture, able to serve food needs and service the industrial sector.

OVERVIEW

Ensuring food security by encouraging investment in food production and processing, and manufacturing of agricultural implements in Kaduna State.



The AGRICULTURE TRANSFORMATION PLAN

The Kaduna State APC shall continue to focus on agriculture for

food security and economic prosperity.

Expanding support for Agriculture

- 1. Expand linkages between farm and factory, especially for the major crops grown in the state.
- 2. Position the Special Agroprocessing Zone (SAPZ) to offer a bigger market for farmers and serve as a magnet for increased production in the field and greater value-addition to agricultural produce.
- 3. Pursue productivity gains for farmers through more extension services and access to better inputs.
- 4. Support the development of more aggregation centres for agricultural commodities to give smallholder farmers better access to markets and offer more reliable supply sources for off-takers.
- 5. Invest in dry season farming by expanding irrigation facilities, through small and earth dams across the state.
- 6. Public-private partnerships and other initiatives to expand ranching and modern livestock production.

- 7. Create and implement a quality control mechanism that will aid the production and off-take of specific target crops.
- 8. Encourage mixed farming among smallholder farmers to increase food security and resilience in rural communities.
- **9.** Support women and youth groups and people living with disabilities through an agropreneurs initiative across the agricultural value chain.
- 10. Leverage on the State Policy on Agriculture to design and execute a Kaduna State Agriculture Transformation Plan, including a database of farmers and farming groups in the state.

INVESTING IN HUMAN CAPITAL



The Kaduna APC is devoted to building and empowering people for development and prosperity. We believe that people are the resource that create, develop or transform all the resources that make civilised existence possible.

It is well educated and healthy persons that have the skills to exercise initiative and the vigour for the hard work that is required to build a strong society and a prosperous economy.

A progressive commitment to the promotion of equal opportunity for all persons has been a key governance feature in Kaduna State since 2015. This has manifested in a steady commitment to expand access to Education and Health, two key sectors which together have consistently taken the largest chunk of budgetary allocations.



In Education, these funds have enabled a significant revamp of school infrastructure, especially the provision of more classrooms and new schools where needed. Much attention has also been paid to providing classroom furniture, water and sanitation.

These measures have been combined with a continuous programme to improve teacher quality and teaching standards to ensure that education investments produce the desired learning outcomes.

Access to quality care in the Health sector has been vastly expanded through the primary health centres that have been renovated and equipped in each of the 255 wards in the state. This is supported by a state contributory health insurance scheme and significant investments in improved facilities and healthcare personnel in the secondary and tertiary health sector.

Our commitment to human capital development includes a focus on social welfare and liberating empowerment through dedicated funds for women and youths, robust social investment programmes for vulnerable persons and extensive pro-poor interventions.



In 2023 and beyond, the APC Kaduna Team will consolidate on the steady work done to build and develop human capital in the state since 2015 through the following programmes:

EDUCATION

1. Access to Education

- i. Ensure that every child in the state continues to enjoy free Primary and Secondary Education, providing guaranteed education for the first twelve years. We shall ensure that every child from the age of 6 is enrolled in a basic education school for nine years, before moving to the next three years of learning in a senior secondary school, technical or vocational school.
- **ii.** We shall implement the Tertiary Institutions Plan (2018-2027) which seeks to expand access to higher education through a multi-campus system for tertiary institutions.

2. Teacher Welfare & Teaching Standards

The quality of the teacher and the careful nurturing they offer to their pupils is the most significant factor in achieving intended learning outcomes.

- i. Graduates will be encouraged to join the teaching profession while current teachers will be exposed to training for continuous professional development.
- Outstanding teachers will be recognised and rewarded, while still teaching, up to a rank equivalent to permanent secretary grade.

3. Improved School Infrastructure

Sustain the investments being made to improve school infrastructure. School buildings will be renovated, and classroom furniture will be provided, together with water and sanitation to make the school environment conducive to all.

4. Education for Skills

- i. We shall accelerate the transition to skills-based education and training through careful adjustments to the curriculum to ensure that the learning experience emphasises initiative, problem solving, and tangible skills.
- **ii.** We shall build ICT competence in our students from basic education level.
- We will intensify investments in Technical & Vocational Education (TVET) to teach skills and build competence in Agriculture, Engineering, Building Technology, Fabrication, Food Science, Furniture & Wood Joinery.



Specific actions to support a healthy society would be advanced through the following:

HEALTH

1. Primary Health Care

- i. Strengthen the standard of care at the upgraded 255 primary health centres in each ward.
- ii. Upgrade another set of 255 PHCs to further expand access, reduce travel time to the facilities and reduce congestion in high population centres.
- **iii.** Equip more PHCs with solar power to enable them to provide 24-hour services.

2. Contributory Health Insurance Scheme

- i. Enrol more residents into the scheme to make access to health care more affordable and secure a sustainable funding basis for health facilities.
- **ii.** Extend health insurance cover to poor and vulnerable citizens through the basic health care provision fund.
- **iii.** Enrol persons employed in the informal sector into the contributory health insurance scheme.
- iv. Build consensus across the state for adopting contributory health insurance as the most affordable way to access healthcare in public facilities.

The Vision

Continue the APC Kaduna Team's programme to build and strengthen a health care system that is preventive in approach, well equipped and staffed, accessible and affordable, and oriented to deliver a decent standard of care.

Overview

Under our watch, the public health system in Kaduna State will consolidate and strengthen ongoing programmes to improve health outcomes:

- i. Reduce maternal and child mortality.
- **ii.** Expand access to vaccines and medications.
- iii. Ramp up enrolment in contributory health insurance and thereby sustain care for pregnant women and children in public hospitals.
- **iv.** Support senior citizens with subsidised care.
- v. Expand awareness of chronic conditions and empower citizens to take proactive steps to avoid them and to embrace disciplined action to manage them when they happen.
- **vi.** Sustain allocation of 15% or more of the annual state budget to health.



HEALTH

3. Upgrade secondary health centres for stronger service delivery

- i. Intensify renovation of facilities across the state.
- **ii.** Recruit and train more medical professionals to enhance service delivery.
- **iii.** Upgrade and maintain critical equipment.
- iv. Build and equip an infectious disease unit in every general hospital.
- Digitise patients' records and implement electronic medical records system across the health system.

4. Position tertiary health facilities as centres of medical excellence

- i. Equip and manage state-owned tertiary health facilities as world-class centres of medical excellence.
- Build on the outgoing government's investment that secured accreditation as a teaching hospital for Barau Dikko Memorial Hospital by enhancing its capacity in specialist areas.
- iii. Manage and operate the 300-bed specialist hospital to international standards to position Kaduna State as centre for medical tourism in areas like cancer treatment.

SOCIAL WELFARE

1. Strengthen Social Welfare programmes and pro-poor interventions

We will deepen KDSG programmes designed to cater to the interests and needs of women, youths and the vulnerable. We will further empower the agency assigned with the mandate of social development and human services to champion and help integrate pro-poor interventions across government.

2. Youths

Young people are the largest demographic in Kaduna State. The vigour, attitude and brains of our young persons are critical to the future of our state. Young people have played critical roles in

delivering many of the successes recorded in the state since 2015. Our duty is to build more youth talent and sustain the promotion of equal opportunity for all.

From sports to education, skills development and health, our programmes will build and support the ability of young people to thrive.



- i. We will protect the right of all young persons to 12 years of free, primary, secondary, technical, or vocational education.
- We will build and maintain neighbourhood centres for sports and recreation, equip more centres to offer technical and vocational education and strengthen empowerment and job-creating programmes like the Kaduna Startup Entrepreneurship Programme (KADSTEP) and the Kaduna Artisan Development Academy (KADAT).
- We will expand access to quality education and training in IT disciplines to build a skilled workforce and expand employment opportunities.
- iv. We shall promote job creation by maintaining the comprehensive attention paid to promoting the ease of doing business in the state.
- v. Leverage on public-private partnerships for the continuous development of sporting infrastructure to promote sporting activities across the state.

3. Women

We will continue to empower women as dynamic actors in the economy and as capable stakeholders in administering the state. Kaduna State has promoted an unprecedented number of women into leadership roles since 2015.

- i. Our programme will protect women and their health, support their ability to realise their personal potentials and enhance their capacity to contribute to society as citizens.
- ii. Free antenatal care for pregnant women will continue and we will encourage the private sector to follow the state government's by granting their female employees six months of paid maternity leave.
- iii. To promote women's participation in the MSME businesses, we will steadily increase the basket of funds available in the Kaduna State Women Empowerment Fund (KADSWEF) every year.
- **iv.** Sustain and expand the high level of inclusion of women in governance.
- Accelerate enforcement of the Violence Against Persons Law and other laws relevant for the protection of vulnerable groups.



SOCIAL WELFARE

4. Social Investment

We are committed to fighting poverty and the causes of poverty. This is at the core of the Social Protection Policy passed by the APC government of Kaduna State.

i. We will offer relief to citizens most impacted by poverty. Our Social Investment Office will be resourced to expand provision of support for the poor and vulnerable. The State Social Register is providing a credible database for the objective disbursement of targeted interventions for the people who are most in need of it.

iii. Persons living with disability

We are committed to fighting poverty and the causes of poverty. This is at the core of the Social Protection Policy passed by the APC government of Kaduna State.

ii. Persons living with disability

The housing deficit in the country impacts the poor and vulnerable who are often compelled to live in slum conditions in the urban areas. This government has started an affordable social housing programme, side by side with its programme to expand the housing stock through publicprivate partnerships. We shall expand the social housing programme in the state, especially in Kaduna, Kafanchan and Zaria.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT


- i. Sustain and strengthen the pioneering position of Kaduna State in the Open Government Partnership.
- **ii.** Provide timely platforms for citizen input into government policy and the implementation of the reform agenda.
- iii. Embed the State Government's community engagement processes in policy development processes and ensure that government decisions are evidence-based.
- iv. Encourage communities to monitor projects and to engage in collaborations in the area of agriculture, trade and the environment.
